Introduction

This analysis of the Cocopah Indian Tribe was undertaken by the Arizona Rural Policy Institute (ARPI) in the W.A. Franke College of Business at Northern Arizona University for the planning department of the Cocopah Indian Tribe. The ARPI has produced the Demographic Profile for Cocopah Indian Tribe with the latest information available from the 2010 Census and the 2010 American Community Survey (5-year estimates). This document is provided to Arizona tribes as a product of the EDA Technical Assistance Grant to the ARPI at Northern Arizona University.

Although the American Community Survey (ACS) produces population, demographic and housing unit estimates, it is the Census Bureau's Population Estimates Program that produces and disseminates the official estimates of the population for the nation, states, counties, cities and towns and estimates of housing units for states and counties. Therefore, this report incorporates two major data sources. First, the official 2010 Census, primarily from the SF1 data report to produce data on the population, age, race and ethnicity relative to Cocopah Indian Tribe. The second data source is the American Community Survey, 5-year estimate data for the period 2006 to 2010 and is annotated in the document as ACS 2010 (5-year estimates). The 2010 ACS 5-year estimates are based on data collected between January 2006 and December 2010. The data were used to analyze household income, poverty rates, employment, language use and household characteristics for Cocopah Indian Tribe. Only the 5-year estimates are used as the data was provided for small geographic areas, representing the average characteristics over the 5-year period.

The analysis of demographics for the Cocopah Indian Tribe first examines the 2010 Census and then the American Community Survey where data is available. Demographic characteristics are outlined at three separate levels, the State of Arizona, Yuma County and the Cocopah Indian Tribe. Comparisons between the State of Arizona and Yuma County serve to provide further levels of comparison when examining demographic characteristics of the tribe versus the County and the State. Yuma County was chosen as the reference county as all Cocopah tribal lands and communities fall within the County.

Appendix A contains official Census 2010 data, Appendix B contains American Community Survey data (5-Year Estimates), and Appendix C contains the margin of error estimates to be used to calculate the estimates for the American Community Survey data.

Population


The population of the Cocopah Indian Tribe saw a sharp decrease (-20.3%) in 2010 when compared to 2000. This decrease in tribal members, however, may not truly reflect the actual change in the tribal populations between the census periods. The SF1 census is considered the official count, and accounts for only the population within the exterior boundaries of the tribal lands or nation. Both the State (24.6%) and the County (22.3%) grew at roughly equal rates between the last census in 2000 and 2010.

Gender

There are more males (51.1%) than females (48.9%) within the Cocopah Indian Tribe, which closely matches the gender ratio of males (51.5%) to females (48.5%) in the County. The State, however, has slightly more females than males.

Age


Those under 18 years of age represent 25.3 percent of all Cocopah Indian Tribe members, roughly the same proportion for that age group as the State (25.5%), and just slightly lower than Yuma County (28.2%). The fact that one-fourth of the tribe is younger than 18 years of age carries with it important policy implications. This relatively large portion of younger tribal members influences the provision of health and educational services and affects poverty and workforce issues as well.

On the other hand, the tribe has slightly more members who are 65 years or older as a proportion of the total population. This age group, those who have retired and are out of the workforce, accounts for one-fourth (27.2%) of tribal members, which is double the State rate (13.8%) and the County (15.7%). The Cocopah Indian Tribe has a similar age profile to that of other Arizona tribes, with a large percentage of tribal members under age 18. Finally, those age 18 to 64 years account for 47.5 percent of the tribal members, lower than the State (60.7%) and the County (56.2%). The large number of tribal young persons will have an effect on the development of the tribal workforce in the future. See Table 3 and Figure 1.


Figure 2. Age Cohorts for Arizona, Yuma County & the Cocopah Indian Tribe 2010



A population pyramid, also called an age structure diagram, is a graphical illustration that shows the distribution of various age groups in a population (typically that of a country or region of the world), which forms the shape of a pyramid when the population is growing.

The population pyramid below (Figure 3) illustrates the difference between males and females for the 5-year age cohorts. The under-18 age cohorts are symmetrical indicating a relatively even number of males and females. The top of the age pyramid also shows relatively equal numbers of females and males in the 67 to 79 age group. The age pyramid provides an illustrated snapshot of the age structure of the tribal members at the time of the 2010 census.

Population Under 18 Years

Children under 18 years of age account for 25.3 percent of all tribal members. There are 375 males and 442 female tribal members, of whom 24.8 percent are males and 25.8 percent are females. More females appear in age cohorts under 5 years (32.5%) than do males (30.1%), while the sex ratios are similar for those between 5 and 10 and 11 to 17 years of age. See Table 4.

Median Age

The median age (point that splits the population where 50% are above and 50% are below) for the Cocopah Indian Tribe members is 39 years, with males and females aged 40 and 38 years respectively. The median age of tribal members is higher than both the State (36 years) and the County (34 years). This statistic emphasizes the slightly older age profile of the Cocopah Indian Tribe. See Figure 4.

Figure 4. Median Age in Years 2010



Race

Not surprisingly, the majority of the Cocopah Indian Tribe tribal members self-identify as American Indian or Alaska Native alone (64%), while the remaining 36 percent are split between white alone (30%), some other race alone (4%) and multi-race persons (2%). This stands in strong contrast to the State which is 73 percent white alone, and the County which is 70 percent white alone. See Table 6.


Ethnicity


Figure 5. Ethnicity

In terms of ethnicity, only about one tenth (11.5%) of Cocopah tribal members self-identify as Hispanic or Latino. This is lower than the State (29.6%) and much lower than Yuma County (59.7%) where almost two-thirds self-identifying as Hispanic or Latino. See Table 7 and Figure 5.

Households

In 2010, there were 312 households on the Cocopah Indian Tribe, with an average household size of 2.6 persons and an average family size of 3.1 persons. This average household size is the same as the State average (2.6 persons) but smaller than the County average (2.9 persons). The average family size for tribal members (3.1 persons) is slightly smaller than the State (3.2 persons) and the County (3.4 persons). See Figure 6.

The next portion of this analysis concerns household structure. The Census, defines a "household" as a person or group of people who occupy a housing unit. The "householder" is a person in whose name the housing unit is owned, being bought, or rented. A "family household" consists of a householder and one or more people living together in the same household who are related to the householder by birth, marriage, or adoption — it may also include people unrelated to the householder. If the householder is married and living with his/her spouse, then the household is designated a "married-couple household." The remaining types of family households not maintained by a married couple are designated by the sex of the householder. A "non-family household" consists of persons living alone or sharing the home with non-relatives only, such as roommates or an unmarried partner.


Family households (67.3%) predominate on the Cocopah Indian Tribe, although traditional married couple families are in the minority (41.3%), lower than the State (48.1%) or the County (56.8%). Households headed by a female (single moms) account for one-fifth (19.2%) of all households. Almost two-thirds (60.5%) of households are either married couple families (41.3%) or households headed by single mothers (19.2%). Other household structures include non-family households (32.7%), the majority of whom are unmarried partner households (8.3%). See Table 8 and Figure 7.

Unmarried partner households (3.2%) occur at a higher rate in the Cocopah Indian Tribe than at the State (2.9%) or the County (2.2%). Householders with a member over age 65 account for more than one-fourth (28.8%) of all households, occurring at a lower rate than the County (41.1%) and slightly higher than the State (26.4%). Finally, tribal households are more likely to be headed by a single mother with their own children under age 18 (11.9%) than are households in the State (7.1%) or the County (8.5%).

Figure 7. Household Relationships




In terms of household characteristics 38.2 percent of all households are headed by a householder, just higher than the State (37.2%) or the County (33.1%). Spouse-headed households comprise a minority of Cocopah tribal households (15.8%) lower than the State (17.9%) or the County (18.8%). Children comprise one-fourth of all households (24.7%), lower than the State (28.9%) and the County (32.1%). See Table 9 and Figure 8.

Family households dominate among Cocopah Indian Tribe members (67%), compared to the State (66%) and the County (76%). Non-family households account for one-third (33%) of tribal member households, similar to the State (34%) but more than the County (24%). Husband and wife families account for almost two-thirds (61%) of Cocopah Indian Tribe households, rates that are lower than the State (73%) or the County (75%). Households on the Cocopah Indian Tribe are twice as likely to be headed by a female householder (29%) with no husband present. Households headed by single mothers are far less prevalent at the State (12%) or County (14%) levels. Households on the Cocopah Indian Tribe are less likely (29%) to have children under the age of 18 living in the household, than is the case in the State (34%) or the County (41%). Figure 9. Households headed by single mothers




Children Under 18 Years Age Living with Grandparent


Figure 10. Percentage of children under 18 living with a grandparent householder

Children under age 18 are twice as likely to live with grandparents on the Cocopah Indian Tribe (7.6%) than they are at the State (2.3%) or in the County (3.3%). There are few differences between the proportions of children by age living with grandparents, when comparing the Cocopah Indian Tribe with the State or the County. See Table 11 and Figure 10.

Presence of Multi-generational Households

Households on the Cocopah Indian Tribe are more likely to be multi-generational (6.7%), than the State (4.9%) but less than the County (7.7%). The Census defines multi-generational families as family households consisting of more than two generations, such as a householder living with his/her children and grandchildren. Multi-generational family households may be more likely to reside in areas where new immigrants live with their relatives, in areas where housing shortages or high costs force families to double up their living arrangements, or in areas that have relatively high rates of out-of-wedlock childbearing. Figure 11. Presence of multigenerational households




Household Income

The median household income for the Cocopah Indian Tribe is \$43,300 more than the County (\$40,340) but less than the State (\$51,310). One-fourth (26%) of all households on the Cocopah Indian Tribe have incomes of less the \$20,000 when compared to the State (17%), and the County (22%). Tribal members are as likely to have household incomes between \$20,000 and \$40,000 (22%) as are households in the State (22%), but households in the County are less likely (28%). Supplemental Income

Households on the Cocopah Indian Tribe are twice as likely (61%) to have social security income than are residents of the State (29%) and the County (34%). More tribal members (45%) have retirement income than do residents of the County (21%) and the State (19%). See Table 13 and Figure 13.

Figure 13. Supplemental Income



Other Income

Per capita income on the Cocopah Indian Tribe (\$18,599) is the same as per capita income for the County (\$18,418) but lower than the State (\$25,680). Correspondingly, median earnings for workers (\$16,667) are lower both the County (\$21,833) and the State (\$29,573). See Table 14.


Poverty

Poverty rates on the Cocopah Indian Tribe Reservation (32%) are higher than the State (15%) and County (21%) rates. Four-fifths (80%) of all children under 18 years of age are considered to be living in poverty, while one-fourth (20%) of tribal members between 18 and 64 also live in poverty. Almost one-third (29%) of persons living in families on the Cocopah Indian Tribe live in poverty, a higher rate than those at the State (13%) or the County levels (20%). One-tenth of all persons over 65 years of age (11%) live in poverty, slightly higher than the State (8%) but less than the County (13%) poverty rates for this age group. See Table 15 and Figure 14.

Children in Poverty

The rates of children under 18 years of age living in poverty are twice as high for the tribe (32%) as the State (15%) and one third higher than the County (21%). The highest poverty rates for tribal members are for children between 6 and 17 years of age; more than half of school age children live below the poverty level (53%). See Table 16.

Households in Poverty

The Census Bureau uses a set of money income thresholds that vary by family size and composition to determine who is poor. If a family's income is less than a family's threshold, then that family and every individual in it, is considered poor. Further the ratio of income to poverty can be used to measure the degree or depth of poverty. The ratio of income to poverty compares a person's income with their poverty threshold, and expresses the comparison as a fraction. For example, a poverty ratio of 1.0 (income at 100% of poverty level) means a person is living right at the poverty line; a ratio of 0.5 (income at 50% of poverty level) would mean that a person is living in a household making only half the income designated as the poverty threshold. The Census Bureau describes those with family incomes below one half of their poverty threshold as being "severely poor." People with incomes at or above their threshold but below 125 percent of their threshold are classified as "near poor."


Less than one-third (31%) on the Cocopah Indian Tribe tribal members are classified as "severely poor," with poverty ratios that ranges from below 0.5 to .99. These rates are much higher than the State (15%) or the County (21%). A further 2 percent of tribal members are classified as "near poor" with poverty ratios between 1.00 and 1.24. The data indicates that more than one-third (33%) of households live below the poverty line, while the remaining 67 percent are above the poverty line. See Table 17 and Figure 15.

Households Receiving Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program (SNAP)

More than ten percent (14.0%) of all households on the Cocopah Reservation receive assistance from the Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program (SNAP). This rate is higher than the State (9.1%) but lower than the County (16.9%). One-tenth of households (9.5%) on the Cocopah Reservation that receive SNAP assistance contain at least one person living in the household over 60 years of age. This rate is twice that of the County (4.7%), and five times the State (2.0%) rate. See Table 18.

Fertility


The birth rate for women between the ages of 15 and 50 years for the Cocopah Indian Tribe is 5.0 percent, slightly lower than the County (7.8%) and the State (6.2%). The birth rate for unmarried mothers on the Cocopah Indian Tribe Reservation (6.3%) is higher than the State (4.3%) and the County (5.0%) rate. See Table 19 and Figure 16.

APPENDIX C: THE COCOPAH INDIAN TRIBE AMERICAN COMMUNITY SURVEY 2010, 5-YEAR ESTIMATES MARGIN OF ERROR ESTIMATES

ACS Margin of Error Estimates

The ACS estimates are based on data from a sample of housing units and people in the population, not the full populations. For this reason, ACS estimates have a degree of uncertainty associated with them, called sampling error. In general, the larger the sample, the smaller the level of sampling error. The ACS calculates standard errors for each estimate produced and publishes the 90 percent confidence level margins of error (the Census Bureau standard). You can be 90 percent confident that the interval within the margin of error from the estimate includes the true value. Users can add and subtract the margin of error value from the estimate to find the top and bottom of the range within which the ACS is 90 percent confident in their estimate lies.

Understanding margin of error

A term you will often come across in survey research is "within the margin of error." Most people hear the term frequently during election season when results from polls are reported. Many surveys and polls collect data from a representative sample of a population to make determinations about a larger population. Results would be somewhat different each time the survey is administered to a different representative sample. The margin of error accounts for these differences by calculating an upper and lower boundary the true result would likely fall between if every member of population was surveyed.

For example, in the case of the Cocopah Indian Tribe the ACS has established that there are 420 households represented on the Cocopah Reservation. The survey also indicates that there are 319 family households (families) with a margin of error of plus or minus (±) 8.2 percent and 76.0 percent of the respondents responding indicated that they were in fact family households. The margin of error tells us that if the same survey were administered to the Cocopah Tribal members again, it is highly probable that the percent of "family household" responses would be between 67.8 percent and 84.2 percent, or 76.0 percent ± 8.2 percent.
