Introduction

This analysis of the Kaibab Paiute Tribe was undertaken for the Grants & Contract Office of the Kaibab Paiute Tribe by the Arizona Rural Policy Institute (ARPI) in the W.A. Franke College of Business at Northern Arizona University. The ARPI was asked to update the Demographic Profile for Kaibab Paiute, with the latest information available from the 2010 Census and the 2010 American Community Survey (5-year estimates). Once the American Community Survey (ACS) data estimates for the 5 years from 2006-2010 series became available the ARPI completed the analysis, which follows in the document.

Although the American Community Survey (ACS) produces population, demographic and housing unit estimates, it is the Census Bureau's Population Estimates Program that produces and disseminates the official estimates of the population for the nation, states, counties, cities and towns and estimates of housing units for states and counties. Therefore, this report incorporates two major data sources: (1) the official 2010 Census, primarily from the SF1 data report to produce data on the population, age, race and ethnicity relative to Pascua Yaqui; and, (2) the ACS 5-year estimate data for the period 2006 to 2010, which is annotated in the document as ACS 2010 (5 -year estimates). The 2010 ACS 5-year estimates are based on data collected between January 2006 and December 2010. The data were used to analyze household income, poverty rates, employment, language use and household characteristics for the Kaibab Paiute Tribe. Only the 5-year estimates are used as the data was provided for small geographic areas, representing the average characteristics over the 5-year period.

The analysis of demographics for the Kaibab Paiute Tribe first examines the 2010 Census and then the ACS data where available. Demographic characteristics are outlined at three separate levels – the State of Arizona, Mohave County and the Kaibab Paiute Tribe. This data for the State of Arizona and Mohave County allow the tribe to compare its demographic characteristics.

The attached Excel spreadsheet contains the official tabular data for the seven districts from the ACS along with the margins of error used to calculate the estimates for the ACS.

Population


The Kaibab Paiute Tribe grew by about a fourth (22.4%) between the last census in 2000 and 2010, not quite as fast as the State (24.6%) or the County (29.1%). This rate may be an underestimate, however, since it reflects growth by birthrate alone and not growth through in-migration as is the case with both the State and the County.

Gender

There are significantly more females (57.1%) than males (42.9%) within the Kaibab Paiute Tribe. The gender ratio for men in the Kaibab Paiute Tribe is lower than for the State (49.7%) or the County (49.6%), while females (57.1%) comprise a larger proportion of the population among the Kaibab Paiute that either the State (50.3%) or the County (50.4%).

Age


The Kaibab Paiute Tribe is dominated by those under 18 years of age. The under-18 population accounts for 40.8 percent of all tribal members, representing a far larger portion of tribal members than the same age group does for the State (25.5%) or Mohave County (20.6%). The fact that two out of five tribal members are younger than 18 years of age carries with it some fairly important policy implications. The large portion of younger tribal members influences the provision of health and educational services as well as poverty and workforce issues as well.

At the other extreme, the tribe has fewer members who are 65 years or older. This age group, consisting of those who have retired and are out of the workforce, accounts for only 6.3 percent of tribal members which is half that at the State (13.8%) and one-fourth that at the County (23.3%) levels, indicating again the overall youthful profile of the tribe. Finally, those age 18 to 64 years account for 52.9 percent of the tribal members, which is below that of the State (60.7%) and the County (56.1%). The large number of tribal young persons will have an effect on tribal workforce issues in the future. See Table 3 and Figure 1.


Figure 2. Age Cohorts for Arizona, Mohave County & Kaibab Paiute Tribe 2010



A population pyramid, also called an age structure diagram, is a graphical illustration that shows the gender distribution of various age groups in a population (typically that of a country or region of the world), which forms the shape of a pyramid when the population is growing.

The population pyramid below (Figure 3) illustrates the difference between males and females for the 5-year age cohorts. The under-18 age cohorts are un-symmetrical indicating a somewhat uneven number of males and females, while the population between 20 and 21 years of age are almost missing from the distribution. At the very top of the age pyramid there tend to be more females than males, a demographic reality as women generally live longer than men. The age pyramid provides an illustrated snapshot of the age structure of the tribal members at the time of the 2010 census.

Population Under 18 Years

Children under 18 years of age account for 41 percent of all tribal members. Of the 103 males and 137 female tribal members, 43 percent of all males are under age 18 and 39.4 percent of all females are under age 18. There are a few more males under age 5 (39%) than females (33%), and there are more males (39%) than females (26%) between the age of 5 and 10 years. The sex ratio is reversed with the 11 to 17 year age cohort, where there are more females (33%) than males (25%). See Table 4.

Median Age

The median age (point that splits the population, where 50% are above and 50% are below) for Kaibab Paiute tribal members is 26 years, with males slightly younger at 23 years and females a little older at 28 years. The median age of tribal members is considerably lower than the State (36 years of age) and much lower than the County (48 years). This once more serves to emphasize the overall young age of tribal members. See Figure 4.

Figure 4. Median Age in Years 2010



Race

Not surprisingly, the majority of Kaibab Paiute tribal members identify themselves as American Indian or Alaska Native alone (85%), while the remaining 15 percent are split between white alone, some other race alone, and multi-race persons. This stands in strong contrast to the State which is 73 percent white alone, and the County which is 87 percent white alone. See Table 6.


Ethnicity

In terms of ethnicity, only one-twentieth (5.4%) of Kaibab Paiute tribal members identify themselves as Hispanic or Latino. This is lower than the surrounding County (13.5%) and much lower than the State, where 29.6 percent self-identify as Hispanic or Latino. See Table 7 and Figure 5.

Households

In 2010, there were 79 households on the Kaibab Paiute Tribe, with an average household size of 3 persons and an average family size of 4 persons. The average household size of 3 persons is the same as the State average (3.0 persons) and slightly larger than the County average (2.4 persons). The average family size for tribal members (3.9 persons) is larger than the State (3.0 persons) and the County (2.9 persons). See Figure 6.


A "household" is a person or group of people who occupy a housing unit. The "householder" is the person in whose name the housing unit is owned, being bought, or rented. A "family household" consists of a householder and one or more people living together in the same household who are related to the householder by birth, marriage, or adoption — it may also include people unrelated to the householder. If the householder is married and living with his/her spouse, then the household is designated a "married-couple household." The remaining types of family households not maintained by a married couple are designated by the sex of the householder. A "nonfamily household" consists of a person living alone or a householder who shares the home with nonrelatives only; for example, with roommates or an unmarried partner.

Family households (63.3%) predominate on the Kaibab Paiute reservation; traditional married couple families are, however, in the minority (26.6%), at rates about half that of the State (48.1%) or the County (49.5%). The largest percentage of households, although not a plurality (31.6%), are female head of households, no husband present, or single moms in other words. More than half (58.2%) of all households are either married couple families (26.6%) or households headed by single mothers (31.6%). Other household structures include non-family households (36.7%) and unmarried partner households (15.2%). See Table 8 and Figure 7.



Unmarried partner households (15.2%) occur at about twice the rate of the State (7.8%) or the County (8.6%). Households with a member over age 65 account for a far smaller percentage of the tribal population (16.5%) than similar age cohorts in the State (23.5%) or County (36.4%) populations. Finally, tribal households are more than four times as likely to have households headed by a single mother with their own children under age 18 (31.6%) than the State (7.1%) or the County (5.3%).

Figure 7. Household Relationships




In terms of household characteristics 32.9 percent of all households are headed by a householder, lower than the State where 37.2 percent of households are headed by a householder and the County where 41.2 percent of households are headed by a householder. Spouse-headed households comprise a minority of Kaibab Paiute tribal households (8.8%) far less than the State (17.9%) or the County (20.4%). Children comprise more than two-fifths of all Kaibab Paiute households (44.2%), greater than the State (28.9%) or the County (23.3%). See Table 9 and Figure 8.

Family households dominate among Kaibab Paiute tribal members (63%), which compares well with 66 percent for the State and 65 percent for the County. Non-family households account for about one third (37%) of Kaibab Paiute tribal member households, again similar to the State (34%) and County (35%). Husband and wife families account for 42 percent of households, whereas residents of the State (73%) and the County (76%) are more than twice as likely to live in husband and wife households. Households on the Kaibab Paiute Tribe are four times more likely to be headed by a female householder (50%) with no husband present. State (12%) and County (10%) rates for single mother households are far less prevalent. Households on the Kaibab Paiute Tribe are more likely (48%) to have children under the age of 18 living in the household, than the State (34%) and the County (35%). See Table 10, and Figure 9.



Figure 9. Households headed by single mothers




Children Under 18 Years Age Living with Grandparent

Children under age 18 are three times more likely to live with grandparents on the Kaibab Paiute Tribe (6.3%) than they are at the State (2.3%) or in the County (2.1%). There are few differences between the proportions of children by age living with grandparents; the only exception is that more school-age children between the ages of 6 and 11 live with their grandparents (46.7%) than at the State (29.5%) or County (30.4%) levels. 
Figure 10. Percentage of children under 18 living with a grandparent householder



Presence of Multi-generational Households

Households on the Kaibab Paiute Tribe are almost twice as likely to be multi-generational (7.6%), as in the State (4.9%) or the County (3.7%). The Census defines multi-generational families as family households consisting of more than two generations, such as a householder living with his/her children and grandchildren. Multi-generational family households may be more likely to reside in areas where new immigrants live with their relatives, in areas where housing shortages or high costs force families to double up their living arrangements, or in areas that have relatively high rates of out-of-wedlock childbearing. Household Income


The median household income for the Kaibab Paiute Tribe is \$28,750, far less than both the County (\$49,510) and the State (\$50,448). Tribal members are more likely to have lower household incomes than either the State or the County. In fact, households are twice as likely to have incomes of less the \$20,000 (37%) than are the State (17%) or the County (19%). Tribal members are twice as likely (52%) to have household incomes between \$20,000 and \$40,000 than the State and the County, 22 percent respectively. Correspondingly, no tribal households have incomes over \$60,000, compared to large percentages in the State (42%) and the County (41%). See Table 12 and Figure 12.

Supplemental Income

Households on the Kaibab Paiute Tribe are three times as likely (29%) to receive Food Stamps than are residents of the State (10%) and the County (12%). Percent of persons on retirement income (27%) in the tribe is about the same as the county (29%) but larger than the State (19%). See Table 13 and Figure 13.

Figure 13. Supplemental Income



Other Income

Per capita Income on the Kaibab Paiute Tribe (\$10,866) is about half of the per capita income for the County (\$21,523) and the State (\$25,680). Correspondingly, median earnings for workers (\$7,159) fall far below the County (\$22,472) and the State (\$29,754), although median earnings for female full-time workers (\$26,667) is much closer to that of the State and County. Poverty


Poverty rates on the Kaibab Paiute Tribe (24%) are substantially higher than the State (15%) and the County (16%) rates, although no children under 18 years of age (0%) are considered to be living in poverty, while one in five persons (19%) between 18 and 64 are considered to live in poverty. Half (50%) of tribal members over 65 years of age live in poverty, five times the State (8%) and the County (7%) rates. See Table 15 and Figure 14.

Households in Poverty

The Census Bureau uses a set of money income thresholds that vary by family size and composition to determine who is poor. If a family's income is less than a family's threshold, then that family and every individual in it, is considered poor. Further the ratio of income to poverty can be used to measure the degree or depth of poverty. The ratio of income to poverty compares a person's income with their poverty threshold, and expresses the comparison as a fraction. For example, a poverty ratio of 1.0 (income at 100% of poverty level) means a person is living right at the poverty line; a ratio of 0.5 (income at 50% of poverty level) would mean that a person is living in a household making only half the income designated as the poverty threshold. The Census Bureau describes those with family incomes below one half of their poverty threshold as being "severely poor." People with incomes at or above their threshold but below 125 percent of their threshold are classified as "near poor."


Almost one-fifth of all households (24%) on the Kaibab Paiute Tribe have a poverty ratio of between 0.5 and .99 or "severely poor," a rate that is twice that of the State rate (15%) or the County rate (16%). A further 11 percent of tribal member are classified as "near poor" with poverty ratios between 1.00 and 1.24, twice the rate of the State (5%) or County (6%). See Table 17 and Figure 15.

Households Receiving Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program (SNAP)

More than one fourth of the households (29.0%) on the Kaibab Paiute Tribe receive assistance from the Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program (SNAP) or food stamps. This rate is about three times greater than the State (9.1%) or the County (11.6%). The proportion of elderly, those over 65 years of age, receiving SNAP assistance (6.5%) is also much higher than the proportion for the same age groups at the State (2.0%) and County (2.9%) levels. 
Fertility

The birth rate for women between the ages of 15 and 50 years is considerably higher for the Kaibab Paiute Tribe (15%) than for the State (6%) or the County (5%). The proportion of unmarried women giving birth on the Kaibab Paiute Tribe (23%) is many times higher than the State (4%) and the County (4%). See Table 19 and Figure 16.

APPENDIX C: KAIBAB PAIUTE TRIBE AMERICAN COMMUNITY SURVEY 2010, 5-YEAR ESTIMATES MARGIN OF ERROR ESTIMATES

ACS Margin of Error Estimates

The ACS estimates are based on data from a sample of housing units and people in the population, not the full populations. For this reason, ACS estimates have a degree of uncertainty associated with them, called sampling error. In general, the larger the sample, the smaller the level of sampling error. The ACS calculates standard errors for each estimate produced and publishes the 90 percent confidence level margins of error (the Census Bureau standard). You can be 90 percent confident that the interval within the margin of error from the estimate includes the true value. Users can add and subtract the margin of error value from the estimate to find the top and bottom of the range within which the ACS is 90 percent confident in their estimate lies.

Understanding margin of error

A term you will often come across in survey research is "within the margin of error." Most people hear the term frequently during election season when results from polls are reported. Many surveys and polls collect data from a representative sample of a population to make determinations about a larger population. Results would be somewhat different each time the survey is administered to a different representative sample. The margin of error accounts for these differences by calculating an upper and lower boundary the true result would likely fall between if every member of population was surveyed.

For example, in the case of the Kaibab Paiute Tribe the ACS has established that there are 62 households represented on the Kaibab Paiute Tribe. The survey also indicates that there are 23 family households (families) with a margin of error of plus or minus (±) 20.9 percent and 37.1 percent of the respondents responding indicated that they were in fact family households. The margin of error tells us that if the same survey were administered to the Kaibab Paiute tribal members again, it is highly probable that the percent of "family household" responses would be between 16.2 percent and 58.0 percent, or 37.1 percent ± 20.9 percent.
