Challenges:

Although ADOA/GFR staff has been very successful working with many tribes in Arizona, there are several tribes that have not extended an invitation to us for a presentation on 9-1-1 or FirstNet and have not responded to requests from ADOA/GFR staff. A significant challenge encountered by tribes in establishing 9-1-1 in their communities is the successful completion of a 9-1-1 Service Plan required for state funding and the addressing or geocoding necessary for 9-1-1 deployment. Staff will continue to work through state and federal tribal liaisons, local agencies as well as other groups like the Indian Country Intelligence Network (ICIN) and Inter-Tribal Council of Arizona (ITCA) to establish a relationship with tribes and continue to seek opportunities to engage tribes to provide valuable emergency communications to tribal areas.
