Introduction

This analysis of the Ak Chin Indian Community was undertaken by the Arizona Rural Policy Institute (ARPI) in the W.A. Franke College of Business, at Northern Arizona University for the planning department of Ak Chin Indian Community. The ARPI has produced the Demographic Profile for Ak Chin Indian Community, with the latest information available from the 2010 Census and the 2010 American Community Survey (5 year estimates). Once the American Community Survey (ACS) data estimates for the 5 year 2006-2010 series became available the ARPI completed the analysis, which follows in the document. This document is provided to Arizona tribes as a product of the EDA Technical Assistance grant provided by the EDA to the ARPI at Northern Arizona University.

Although the American Community Survey (ACS) produces population, demographic and housing unit estimates, it is the Census Bureau's Population Estimates Program that produces and disseminates the official estimates of the population for the nation, states, counties, cities and towns and estimates of housing units for states and counties. Therefore, this report incorporates two major data sources. First, the official 2010 Census, primarily from the SF1 data report to produce data on the population, age, race and ethnicity relative to Ak Chin. The second data source is the American Community Survey, 5-year estimate data for the period 2006 to 2010 and is annotated in the document as ACS 2010 (5 year estimates). The 2010 ACS 5-year estimates are based on data collected between January 2006 and December 2010. The data were used to analyze household income, poverty rates, employment, language use and household characteristics for Ak Chin Indian Community. Only the 5-year estimates are used as the data was provided for small geographic areas, representing the average characteristics over the 5-year period.

The analysis of demographics for Ak Chin Indian Community first examines the 2010 Census and then the American Community Survey where data is available. Demographic characteristics are outlined by three separate levels, the State of Arizona, Pinal County and the Ak Chin Indian Community. Comparisons between the State of Arizona and Pinal County serve to provide further levels of comparison when examining demographic characteristics of the tribe versus the County and the State.

The attached Excel spreadsheet contains the official tabular data for the seven districts from the ACS along with the margins of error used to calculate the estimates for the ACS.

Population


The population of the Ak Chin Indian Community increased dramatically (34.9%) in 2010 when compared to 2000. This increase, however, may not truly reflect the actual change in the tribe between the census periods. Both the state (24.6%) and the county (109.1%) grew between the last census in 2000 and 2010. In fact the population of Pinal County doubled between the 2000 and 2010 Census. The increase in tribal members, however, may not truly reflect the actual change in the tribal population between the census periods. The SF1 census is considered the official count, and accounts for only the population within the exterior boundaries of the tribal lands or nation. The rate of population growth of Pinal County is the highest in the State and one of the highest in the Nation.

Gender

There are slightly more females (52.2%) than males (47.8%) within the Ak Chin Indian Community. The gender ratios in the Ak Chin Indian Community are lower for males in both the State (49.7%) and the County (52.5%). Females (52.8%) comprise a larger proportion of the population among the Ak Chin tribal members than either the State (50.3%) or the County (47.8%).

Age

The Ak Chin Indian Community is dominated by those under 18 years of age. The under-18 year population accounts for 43.4 percent of all tribal members, representing a far larger portion of tribal members than the same age group does for the State (25.5%) and Pinal County (26.5%). The fact that more than one-third of the tribe is younger than 18 years of age carries with it important policy implications. The large portion of younger tribal members influences the provision of health and educational services as well as poverty and workforce issues as well.

On the other hand, the tribe has fewer members who are 65 years or older. This age group, those who have retired and are out of the workforce account for only 4.1 percent of tribal members when compared to 13.8 percent for the state and 13.9 percent for the county. Once more the reduction at the bottom of the age cohort indicates the overall youthful profile of the tribe. Finally, those age 18 to 64 years account for 52.5 percent of the tribal members, which compares favorably to the State (60.7%) and lower than the County (59.6%). The large number of tribal young persons will have an effect on the development of the tribal workforce in the future. See Table 3, and Figure 1.




Figure 2. Age Cohorts for Arizona, Pinal County & the Ak Chin Indian Community 2010

A population pyramid, also called an age structure diagram, is a graphical illustration that shows the distribution of various age groups in a population (typically that of a country or region of the world), which forms the shape of a pyramid when the population is growing.




Figure 3. Population Pyramid - the Ak Chin Indian Community 2010

The population pyramid below (Figure 3) illustrates the difference between males and females for the 5 year age cohorts. The under-18 age cohorts are symmetrical indicating that there are an even number of males and females. The population between 20 and 21 years of age represent a small part of the distribution. At the top of the age pyramid there are more females than males. This is also a demographic reality as women tend to live longer than men. The age pyramid provides an illustrated snapshot of the age structure of the tribal members at the time of the 2010 census.

Population Under 18 Years

Children those under 18 years of age account for 43.5 percent of all tribal members. There are 478 males and 523 female tribal members, of those 44.1 percent of all males are under age 18 and 42.6 percent of all females are under age 18. There are more males under age 5 years (41.7%) than females (39.9%), while the sex ratios are similar for those between 5 and 10 and 11 to 17 years of age. See Table 4.

Median Age




Figure 4. Median Age in Years 2010

The median age (point that splits the population where 50% are above and 50% are below) for the Ak Chin Indian Community members is 23 years, with males and females aged 23.4 and 23.1 years respectively. The median age of tribal members is at least ten years younger than the State median (36 years of age) and half the median age of the County 48 years. This statistic serves once more to emphasize the overall younger age of tribal members on the Ak Chin Indian Community. See Figure 4.

Race

Not surprisingly, the majority of the Ak Chin Indian Community tribal members identify themselves as American Indian or Alaska Native alone (73%), while the remaining 27 percent are split between white alone and some other race alone and multi race persons. This stands in strong contrast to the State which is 73 percent white alone, and the County which is 72 percent white alone. See Table 6.

Ethnicity


In terms of ethnicity, almost one-fifth (5.3%) of the Ak Chin Indian Community tribal members, self-identify themselves as Hispanic or Latino. This is lower than the surrounding County where 27.6% percent identify themselves as Hispanic or Latino and much lower than the State where 29.6 percent identify themselves as Hispanic or Latino. Households




Figure 6. Average Household and Family Size

In 2010, there were 282 households on the Ak Chin Indian Community, with an average household size of 3.5 persons and an average family size of 4.1 persons as well. The average household size of 3.5 persons is larger than the State average (3.0 persons) and larger than the County average (2.8 persons). The average family size for tribal members (4.1 persons) is also larger than the State and the County, where the average is 3.2 persons respectively. See Figure 6.

The next portion of this analysis concerns households and their structure. The Census, defines as "household" as a person or group of people who occupy a housing unit. The "householder" is a person in whose name the housing unit is owned, being bought, or rented. A "family household" consists of a householder and one or more people living together in the same household who are related to the householder by birth, marriage, or adoption — it may also include people unrelated to the householder. If the householder is married and living with his/her spouse, then the household is designated a "married-couple household." The remaining types of family households not maintained by a married couple are designated by the sex of the householder. A "nonfamily household" consists of a person living alone or a householder who shares the home with nonrelatives only; for example, with roommates or an unmarried partner.




Figure 7. Household Relationships

Family households (77.7%) predominate on the Ak Chin Indian Community, traditional married couple families are however in the minority (41.5%) lower than the State (48.1%) or the County (55.8%). Households headed by a female head of household (single moms) account for almost one-fourth (28.4%) of all households. Two-thirds (69.6%) of all households are either married couple families (41.5%) or households headed by single mothers (28.4%). Other household structures include non-family households (22.3%), the majority of whom are unmarried partner households (3.9%). See Table 8 and Figure 7.

Unmarried partner households (3.9%) occur at a much lower rate in the Ak Chin Indian Community than at the State (7.8%) or the County (8.5%). Householders with a member over age 65 account for a larger percentage of the tribal population (55.3%) than similar age cohorts in the State (26.4%) and County (37.0%) populations. Finally, tribal households are more than three times as likely to be headed by a single mother with their own children under age 18 (13.8%) than the State (7.1%) or the County (6.7%).


In terms of household characteristics 25.5 percent of all households are headed by a householder, lower than the State where 37.2 percent of households are headed by a householder and the County (33.4%). Spouse headed households comprise a minority of Ak Chin Indian Community tribal households (6.4%) far less than the State (17.9%) or the County (18.7%). Children comprise almost one-third of all households (34.2%), greater than the State (28.9%) or the County (28.3%). See Table 9 and Figure 8.




Figure 9. Households headed by single mothers

Family households dominate among Ak Chin Indian Community tribal members (80%), compared to 66 percent for the State and 73percent for the County. Non-family households account for one fifth (20%) of Ak Chin tribal member households and less for the State (34%) or County (27%). Husband and wife families account for only one-third (31%) of households, whereas residents of the State (73%) and the County (76%) are more than twice as likely to live in husband and wife households. Households on the Ak Chin Indian Community are three times more likely to be headed by a female householder (37%) with no husband present. Households headed by single mothers are far less prevalent at the State (12%) or County (12%). Households on the Ak Chin Indian Community are more likely (56%) to have children under the age of 18 living in the household, than the State (34%) and the County (37%). See Table 10, and Figure 9.

Children Under 18 Years Age Living with Grandparent





Figure 10. Percentage of children under 18 living with a grandparent householder

Children under age 18 are four times as likely to live with grandparents on the Ak Chin Indian Community (8.3%) than they are at the State (2.3%) or in the County (2.5%). There are few differences between the proportions of children by age living with grandparents, when comparing the Ak Chin Indian Community, the State or the County. See Table11 and Figure 10.

Presence of Multigenerational Households

Households on the Ak Chin Indian Community are two times more likely to be multigenerational (11.7%), than the State (4.9%) and the County (5.5%). The Census defines multigenerational families as family households consisting of more than two generations, such as a householder living with his/her children and grandchildren. Multigenerational family households may be more likely to reside in areas where new immigrants live with their relatives, in areas where housing shortages or high costs force families to double up their living arrangements, or in areas that have relatively high rates of out-of-wedlock childbearing. Household Income

The median household income for the Ak Chin Indian Community is \$32,022, more than the County (\$28,779) and less than the State (\$51,310). Tribal members are more likely to have lower household incomes than both the State and the County. In fact households are twice as likely to have incomes of less the \$20,000 (38%) than is the State (17%), and the County (16%). Tribal members are as likely (20%) to have household incomes between \$20,000 and \$40,000 and \$40,000 and \$60,000 as the State and the County. No tribal members have incomes in excess of \$60,000. 


Figure 12. Percentage of household income by range




Figure 13. Supplemental Income




Poverty

Poverty rates on the Ak Chin Indian Community (42%) are twice as high as the State (15%) and the County (13%). Two-thirds (64%) of all children under 18 years of age are considered to be living in poverty, while one-fourth (26%) of tribal members between 18 and 64 also live in poverty. Two-fifths (44%) of persons living in families on the Ak Chin Indian Community live in poverty, a much higher rate than families in poverty at the state level (13%) or the County (12%). Children in Poverty

The rates of children under 18 years of age living in poverty are three times higher for the tribe (42%) than for the State (15%) or the County (13%). The highest poverty rates for tribal members are recorded for those children between 6 and 17 years of age, where 40 percent of these school age children live below the poverty level. See Table 16.

Households in Poverty

The Census Bureau uses a set of money income thresholds that vary by family size and composition to determine who is poor. If a family's income is less than a family's threshold, then that family and every individual in it, is considered poor. Further the ratio of income to poverty can be used to measure the degree or depth of poverty. The ratio of income to poverty compares a person's income with their poverty threshold, and expresses the comparison as a fraction. For example, a poverty ratio of 1.0 (income at 100% of poverty level) means a person is living right at the poverty line; a ratio of 0.5 (income at 50% of poverty level) would mean that a person is living in a household making only half the income designated as the poverty threshold. The Census Bureau describes those with family incomes below one half of their poverty threshold as being "severely poor." People with incomes at or above their threshold but below 125 percent of their threshold are classified as "near poor."


Almost half of all households (42%) on the Ak Chin Indian Community are classified as "severely poor," with poverty ratios that ranges from below 0.5 to .99. These rates are twice those of the State (15%) or the County (13%). A further 5 percent of tribal member are classified as "near poor" with poverty ratios between 1.00 and 1.24, at the same rate as both the State and County. The data indicates that 47 percent of households are below the poverty line, while the remaining 53 percent are located above the poverty line. See Table 17 and Figure 15.

Households Receiving Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program (SNAP)

One-third of all households (30.6%) on the Ak Chin Indian Community tribal members receive assistance from the Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program (SNAP). This rate is at least four times greater than the State (9.1%) or the County (9.6%). The proportion of elderly, those over 65 years of age, receiving SNAP assistance (0.6%) is a lower proportion for the same age groups than the State (2%) or County (2%). See Table 18.


Fertility

The birth rate for women between the ages of 15 and 50 years for the Ak Chin Indian Community is 8.8 percent in line with the County (8.2%) but higher than the State (6.2%).
